PRINCENT RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS AND STAFF

OF STRAIGHT, INC.

The following is a statement of rules for STRAIGHT, INC.

- 1. Staff shall assist at the time of Intake in the filling out of the Intake forms.
- Staff shall maintain an Observation Book (Obs) containing significant observations from the Group or information that all Staff should be aware of.
- 3. Staff shall have one-to-one sessions with clients.
- 4. A staff member shall be assigned to be sure lunches and dinners are brought to the Group and set up properly.
- 5. There shall be an exercise period every day for at least one-half hour.
- 6. A staff member shall be assigned to handle court cases.
- 7. No client is permitted to have on his person any medications. This does include aspirin. All medications must be prescribed by a licensed physician and handled by one staff member. Medicine shall be locked at all times.
- 8. A staff member shall be assigned to notify the respective school of the child entering STRAIGHT, INC.
- 9. A staff member shall be assigned to stashes. This will include any type of drug the client may have illegally, any stolen merchandise, paraphernalia, or such.
- 10. As the client progresses, he shall submit permissions. This is for the client to request a certain privilege.
- 11. A staff member shall be responsible for finding a temporary home.
- 12. There shall be a work schedule made out for Staff indicating days off.
- 13. Staff shall keep an Attendance Book for all people on the Program.
- 14. Comment sheets are kept on each individual in the Program. These shall be kept in the client's confidential folder.
- 15. Every Monday and Friday the Group shall do "Homes." This is a discussion among the Group members so that the client who is eligible to go home may receive feedback from the Group on how the person is doing.
- 16. Staff shall assist clients in getting jobs. This is for a client who is either out of school or attending school part-time and wants a job.
- 17. Staff shall in no way use physical violence to control clients.
- 18. There shall be no boy/girl relationships and any overt sexual behavior shall not be tolerated.
- 19. This is a drug-free program and the possession, use, or sale of illegal drugs shall not be tolerated.
